

**RULES OF CONVERSION OF GRADES FROM “OLD MATURA”, INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB),
EUROPEAN BACCALAUREATE (EB) AND BACCALAUREATES OBTAINED ABROAD TO “NEW MATURA”
POINTS AND RULES OF CONVERSION OF GRADES FROM FOREIGN DIPLOMAS**

1. General remarks:
 - 1) If a distinction between an advanced level (HL) and a basic level (SL) is not made on a certificate, the points gained via conversion are treated as obtained on an advanced level;
 - 2) “old matura” – means a matura exam passed before the year 2005;
 - 3) “new matura” – means a matura exam passed in the year 2005 or after;
2. Method of conversion of grades from a maturity exam (“old matura”) or certificate of secondary school graduation or higher education diploma:
 - 1) In the case of a different grade scale the conversion of grades to qualification points shall be conducted in accordance with rules equivalent to the rules in the tables (rule of proportion):
 - a) The lowest positive grade corresponds to number 30, and the highest to number 100,
 - b) The lowest positive grade corresponds to number 3.00, and the highest to number 5.00
