1. **BA or MA diploma in philology:**
  - a. **diploma** in the field of **foreign languages** or **applied linguistics**;
  - b. **graduation diploma** from teacher's college of foreign languages;
  - c. **graduation diploma** in the field of **English language** from **Krajowa Szkoła Administracji Publicznej (KSAP)** – National School of Public Administration;
2. **Doctoral** or **professorate** diploma in **English** – English is recognized as the language of instruction of the institution issuing the diploma;
3. **BA or MA diploma** in **English** – the required level of proficiency is provided and English is recognized as the only language of instruction;
4. **International Baccalaureate** diploma;

5. **European Baccalaureate** diploma;
6. **Polish Maturity Diploma**;
7. Confirmation of **English** being the **medium of instruction** – the required level of proficiency is provided and English is recognized as the only language of instruction during the whole duration of the previous education cycle;
